Petuaria ReVisited

The Petuaria ReVisited project is heading for a busy summer with all activities aimed at promoting Brough's Roman past. Work is almost finished on new displays of Roman artefacts from Brough, guarded by a full-sized replica of a Roman Legionary. From the onset, the project has been keen to collaborate with local schools and four handling collections of Roman pottery, tile and other artefacts have been prepared.

Preliminary assessment suggests that this was a remarkable site with massive stone walls which may have served as a storage depot or port, considering its location on the edge of a former inlet of the Humber.

On the afternoon of Sunday 3rd July, there is an opportunity to catch up on the results of two seasons of excavation in Brough, with talks, exhibitions and other activities in Elloughton Village Hall, prior to our third season of community excavation, which will be researching the Roman defences on the Burrs and a neighbouring garden 9th -23rd July.
