We will have the pleasure of welcoming Pipe Major David McRobb who will be playing a piece called 'Diu Regnare', a traditional piping piece. In addition to this, we will also be welcoming Rachel Miller, a local cornet player, who will recite 'Majesty': a piece especially composed for this unique and important event. Attendance is free, but we would advise getting there early, as accurate lighting times will be adhered to. Seating will not be available.

Humber Timelines Big Dig

Throughout this year, a team of archaeologists, historians and local residents from Humber Timelines, in partnership with pupils from local schools and local volunteers, are embarking on an ambitious plan to discover the hidden history of the Humber region. The archaeologists will employ a tried and tested method called test-pitting, to dig numerous holes across the area. Test pits are discrete 1m by 1m holes, which are completely excavated and filled in again in a single day, or over a period of a few days if the participants want to keep going! As these test-pits are dug layer-bylayer, the finds, like pottery, glass, buttons, and coins, are gathered together and analysed according to what soil level they came from. To make this project a success, test-pits need to be dug in as many places as possible across the town, so the team are making a final appeal to local residents as they are seeking the use of private gardens and land wherever homeowners are willing and keen. The techniques used have been designed to cause as little disruption as possible. Tarpaulins are put down as required, and the soil and turf is put back the way it came out of the ground so little trace of the pit is left.
